



WEEK 26: COMMISSION DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. Share a time when you became a diehard fan of something— Apple vs Android, sports team, a diet or exercise program, specific brand, or similar. What was it that convinced you to jump on board?
2. Mark Moore shared the statistic that 96% of Christians never lead another person to faith in Jesus. Why do you think that is?
3. What are some fears that come to mind when thinking about engaging in the Great Commission?
4. Has anyone ever had a bad experience sharing their faith? Talk about it.
5. Read Acts 10-11. What can we learn from Peter’s experience about our own role in the Great Commission?
6. Read Mark 16:15-16, John 20:21-23, & 2 Corinthians 5:20. Take 5 minutes and write down your thoughts on what you just read. Discuss in the group what came to mind as you meditated on these verses?
7. What rights and responsibilities do you feel you have as a “ambassador” of Christ?
8. What is the last big step you took that cause your faith in God to grow? What was the last big step you took toward helping another person grow in their faith? How would you coach another person to take those same steps?

ACTION STEPS

Take 5 minutes and on a 3×5 card, write the names of three people you would like to escort one big step closer to God. As a group, close your time together by praying for God to give you opportunities to do that in simple and practical ways.
